The Marietta Schools Foundation was incorporated in June 1983 as a non-profit 501(c)(3) for the purpose of promoting educational excellence and achievement among the students, faculty, staff, and administration of the Marietta City Schools.

The MSF does not take any fees from contributions! No administrative fees, no handling fees, no service charges. Nothing! Since 1983, 100% of each donation goes toward each contributor's intended purpose.

The Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors who feel the best way to fulfill our purpose is to recognize and reward outstanding students and employees. In addition, we respond to the needs of the classroom teacher in order to provide them with the necessary tools to make them as proficient as possible.

Outstanding students are recognized and rewarded with scholarships provided by the foundation through several scholarship funds that have been endowed specifically for this purpose.

Teachers of the Year, representing each school in the district, are recognized and rewarded with cash awards.

In 2021, the MSF awarded over \$82,000 in new scholarship money, \$22,000 in student funding, and over \$720,000 toward funded projects at MCS, including a \$20,000 donation to the new Vision to Learn initiative.

The MSF has 50 different endowments that, in addition to providing scholarships, go towards such purposes as the Marietta Performance Arts Center, the MCS Band Association, boys and girls basketball, the Culinary Arts Program at MHS, funding for students in need, the Student Life Center, and many more.

Since 1983 the MSF has paid out over \$4,750,000 in support of Marietta City Schools.
